Ardyaloon Aboriginal community

Profile

Ardyaloon is located 200 km north-east of Broome, at the northern end of Cape Leveque on the Dampier Peninsula.

It was settled in the early 1970s and has grown to be one of the largest remote Aboriginal communities in the Western Australia. It is now a service hub for many outstations in the area.

Ardyaloon has more than 300 residents, the majority of whom are members of the Bardi Jawi language groups.
