Bayulu Aboriginal community

Profile

Bayulu is located 10 km south of Fitzroy Crossing on the edge of Gooniyandi country.

The community's population has steadily increased since it was settled in 1987. Bayulu now has about 300 permanent residents, and in periods of flooding there is an influx of residents from smaller outstations.

Residents are from the Walmajarri and Gooniyandi language groups. Bayulu accommodates additional visitors (from other language groups) who come to the settlement for its services.
