Djarindjin Aboriginal community

Profile

Djarindjin is located 170 km north of Broome on the Dampier Peninsula.

The community is a part of a single urban area that incorporates Lombadina Aboriginal community and the Lombadina Mission.

In 1985, Djarindjin was established as a separate governed community, distinct and apart from Lombadina.

Djarindjin has more than 200 residents, the majority are members of the Bardi Jawi language groups.
