## Lombadina Aboriginal community

## **Profile**

Lombadina is located 170 km north of Broome on the Dampier Peninsula.

The community is part of a single urban area that incorporates Djarindjin Aboriginal community and the Lombadina Mission.

The mission was established in 1911 at the site of what is now the Lombadina / Djarindjin township.

Lombadina Aboriginal community has more than 70 residents, the majority of whom are members of the Bardi Jawi language groups.
