Profile

Warmun is located 160 km south-west of Kununurra in the East Kimberley.

The community was established in the 1970s by the Gija people at Turkey Creek.

Warmun has a core population of about 300 - 400 people in the dry season, and the population can increase to 600 people in the wet season.

The majority of Warmun residents are members of the Gija language group.
